The Dayton Boat Club (DBC) adult (masters) rowing program seeks a head coach starting in March 2025. This is a paid part-time position of approximately eight hours per week year-round with three weeks (any 12 practices' worth) of paid vacation, plus paid holidays and breaks at the discretion of the coaches and the team's steering committee. Salary is \$525 per month.

Responsibilities in this year-round position include:

- Design and implement a comprehensive adult training program with typically four practices per week.
- Prepare crews and athletes for national and regional competitions.
- Communicate regularly with athletes about the training program and goals while understanding the broad spectrum of needs, goals, and abilities among adults.
- Contribute to and maintain a positive, inclusive, and supportive team culture.
- Work collaboratively with the coach of the technical/recreational (aka novice) team on strategy, program goals and athlete development.
- Provide fleet and launch maintenance support as needed.
- Participate in team outreach, communications, and fundraising activities as appropriate.
- Provide expert technical coaching to improve skills, technique, and overall performance; conduct occasional video analysis to provide constructive feedback.
- Organize and oversee regatta logistics, including race entries, trailer loading and unloading, boat assignments, and launch/recover support; develop race strategies to optimize performance.

Preferred qualifications

- Experience coaching a competitive rowing team
- Knowledge about coaching rowers of diverse age, size and skill
- Experience as a competitive rower or coxswain

Other requirements

Candidate must be able to pass a criminal background check and either possess or be able to acquire before employment the following:

- Level 1 USRowing coach certification
- First aid and CPR certification
- Boat safety
- USRowing SafeSport training for coaches
